The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Brian Connelly with the pledge of allegiance.

Brian Connelly asked if the board members had any changes to the printed agenda. Rick Lutzi asked to put John Austinson on the agenda after the sheriff's report. A motion was made by Rick Lutzi and seconded by Drew Moessner to approve the written agenda as amended. The motion passed unanimously.

The board reviewed and signed claims for payment as presented. The claims and payroll are as follows:

After review, a motion was made by Rick Lutzi and seconded by Drew Moessner to approve the treasurer's report as given. The motion passed unanimously.

Olmsted County Sheriff

The Olmsted County Deputy was present and was available for questions. He was asked about the ORI numbers and if they were being used by the deputies at this time.

John Austinson

Mr. John Austinson was present and gave the residents information that he will be running for the Minnesota State Senate in 2020. There is also a possibility if Carla Nelson runs and wins the First District representative race in November, a special election will be held in 2019 and he wants to be ready for that if it happens. He answered questions from residents.

OLD BUSINESS TCPA Meeting

Rick Lutzi will be filling in for Drew Moessner at the April 11, 2018 meeting. Drew Moessner reported on the last meeting. They are looking for a secretary for TCPA meetings. Dave Meier has been filling in as secretary. Rick Lutzi was again elected Vice Chairman of the TCPA. Finances remain strong.

ROADS

The clerk's report was reviewed by board members. There was discussion on the Don Nelson driveway application. Chad Schuman and Rick discussed this request and the issues with site lines at the requested site. There was discussion about temporary driveways until some anticipated road work is completed so that a driveway can be located as requested.

The culvert on 60th Street needs cleaning as water was coming out of the ditch and washing a trench in the road and then going back in the ditch. The ditch on 55^{thd} Street also needs cleaning out.

Brian Connelly requested a discussion about trees that are located on a resident's property and falls in the right of way, who is responsible for the timely clean up of the road right of way. Rick Lutzi said the right of way management ordinance he is working on may help address these issues. Olmsted County uses the Minnesota State Statute for right of way management. There is also a suggested Minnesota Association of Townships document that would put a question on the ballot to assign the responsibility back to the landowner to clear rocks, trees, etc. located in our road right of way.

The board discussed spring road inspections. They set a date of April 23 and April 25 at 4:30 p.m. for road inspections. The clerk will post these meeting dates.

Willow Run road condition was discussed. There were not residents present. Brian Connelly read the response we received from Fahrner. The board decided to send this response to all residents along with an invitation to come to our May town board meeting to discuss what needs to be done to this road and the cost of repair.

The board discussed the new quotes on the signs and estimates on cost of posts that will be needed for installation by Olmsted County. There was discussion about how the county may install the signs. The board will review the signs we are proposing to replace to make sure we have all the correct signs ordered.

NEW BUSINESS

CHLORIDE

cards to be sent by April 23 and have the payment due on or before May 21. The motion passed unanimously.

PLANNING AND ZONING AND BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT

The Board reviewed the appointments they made at the Board of Canvas. Dave Sackett has resigned from the Planning and Zoning Board. The board appointed John Donovan and Vincent Hoover as new members of the Planning and Zoning Board.

Rick Lutzi has contacted Dave Rassel and he is willing to serve as an alternate to the Planning and Zoning Board. Brian Connelly has contacted Matt Petersen about being an alternate, but he has not given a definite answer at this point.

A motion was made by Rick Lutzi and seconded by Drew Moessner to appoint Dave Rassel as an alternate to the Planning and Zoning Board. The motion passed unanimously.

The board reviewed the minutes of the last Planning and Zoning meeting. Drew Moessner will contact Paws and Claws about attending the next scheduled meeting for their yearly permit review. Clark Concrete will be sent a notice to attend the next scheduled meeting also.

SPRING DITCH PICKUP

Brian Connelly signed the letter authorizing the Boy Scouts and the Salem Sailors to take items found in our ditch during Apring and Fall pick up to the Olmsted County Recycling Center.

There was also discussion about asking if any of these groups would be interested in doing some pick up during the year when debris is deposited in our ditches. If interested, the board would like a price on what it would cost for this service.

TOWNSHIP ELECTIONS

A motion was made by Drew Moessner and seconded by Rick Lutzi to authorize the clerk to return the approved levy recommendations to Olmsted County. The motion passed unanimously.

LUCA CENSUS

Sharon Petersen noted she has received the information on verifying addresses for Salem Township. The work is due by July 1, 2018.

NORTHERN NATURAL GAS

Rick Lutzi has been working with Terry King about designing the permit for Northern Natural Gas. The board reviewed the permit and made a few changes. A motion was made by Drew Moessner and seconded by Rick Lutzi to have the permit sent to them to be filled out and return a check for the registration. After this permit is returned a supervisor will sign the document. The motion was passed unanimously.

TOWNSHIP CONTRACT FOR PROSECUTION

The board discussed the issues on the ORI number and at this time there is a consensus that Salem Township will not be signing a contract at this time.

ACCESS COMMITTEE MEETING

Rick Lutzi reported on the two meetings that have been held. The committee is working on some sample documents from Courri and Ruppe on driveway access issues and right of way maintenance. Rick has gotten some additional information on what they use for right of way ordinance. Many of the issues will be decided on a case by case basis.

SPRING SHORT COURSE

Rick Lutzi and Drew Moessner reported on their training course at the Event Center. Vince Hoover and Sharon Petersen attended the clerk training session. They reported on the meeting.

ITEMS BROUGHT UP BY BOARD MEMBERS

There was discussion about whether the supervisor's time on monthly roads responsibility ends on the first of the month or on the meeting date. After discussion, it was decided that all transitions will take place on the first of the month.

Drew Moessner reported on the watershed meeting he attended.

Sharon Petersen asked the board to refine the work order process for working with contractors in order to alleviate the issues we had last year. All work should have a written work order.

Brian Connelly reported on the OPEN fORUM meeting he attended at the People's Cooperative offices giving an update on the City of Rochester'S 2040 plan. There was discussion about affordable housing and transportation.

CITIZEN COMMENT

No comments were made.

A motion was made by Drew Moessner and seconded by Rick Lutzi to adjourn the meeting at 10:02 p.m. The motion passed unanimously.
