Olmsted County Road Construction Project Beginning Soon

Culvert Replacement on County State Aid Highway (CSAH) 17 (50th Street SW)

Culvert replacement is scheduled to begin along CSAH 17 (50th Street SW) on Monday, June 15, 2020. The road will be closed 1000' west of the intersection with 110 Avenue SW. Construction is anticipated to be completed by June 19, 2020, weather permitting.

There will be no detour posted. Motorists should expect delays and are to seek alternative routes.

Motorists are reminded to always drive with caution, and never enter a road blocked with barriers or cones. Please reduce your speed and proceed with caution through these work zones.
